If you are interested in visits from the Senior Companion Program, please see Shannon and she will set you up with a volunteer to visit with you.

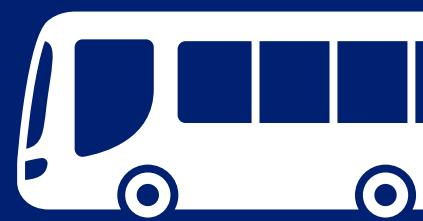

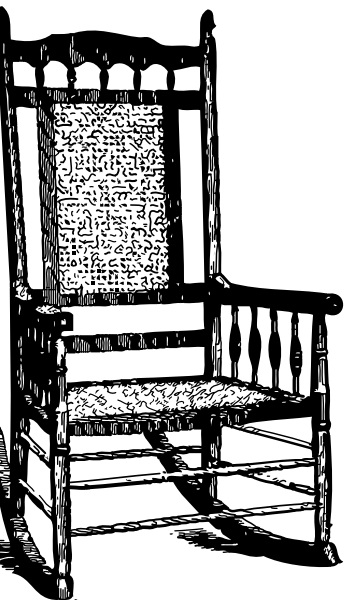
