FINAL PROFESSION OF VOWS

Saturday, April 23, 2022, was a great day of rejoicing and thanksgiving for the community of the Sisters of St. Rita.

I, Sr. Jana Anne, made my Final Profession of Vows before God and the Superior General, Sr. Rita Maria Käs, at St. Rita of Cascia Shrine in Chicago, IL. In making my final profession of perpetual vows, I made a lifelong commitment of myself to our community and vowed to continue to journey with the Sisters of St. Rita in poverty, celibacy, and obedience to God.

I moved from Los Angeles to enter religious life with the Sisters of St. Rita almost 7 years ago, worked at St. Monica's for 3 years, which allowed me to get acquainted with the facility and the community members. During my studies for Chaplaincy, I began working as a full time Hospice Chaplain. Currently I work for Ascension Living Alexian Village in Milwaukee in their Assisted Living & Memory Care facility as a Chaplain. Before I moved to Racine, I was a third order Augustinian, an active member of SVdP, involved in restorative justice and prison ministry, taught catechism at my Church, involved in various Parish committees and I volunteered as a hospital minister. After I joined the Sisters of St. Rita I continued serving the local Parish community by teaching catechism, I'm now leading the bereavement ministry with the deacon at St. Rita's Parish, and I still volunteer as a communion minister at Froedtert Hospital in Milwaukee. I also started a Pocket Prayer Shawl Ministry at St. Monica's in 2017 due to immediate need at Froedtert. To date, the community members have made approximately 7,000 pieces of pocket prayer shawls and donated them to Froedtert Hospital Bereavement in Milwaukee.

These past seven years have been a blessing and I thank you all for allowing me to be a part of your life. Every day I pray for God's grace to grant me to continue to minister and serve Him for many years in the spirit of St. Augustine and St. Rita.
